

Your 2024-25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information the financial aid administrator at your school will compare your FAFSA information with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent (if dependent student) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents and submit the form and other required documents to the financial aid office at Agnes Scott. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact our office as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
